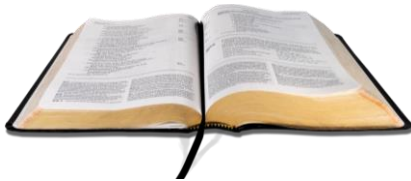

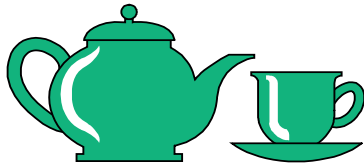

The Requiem will be performed in memory of Derek Oakley.

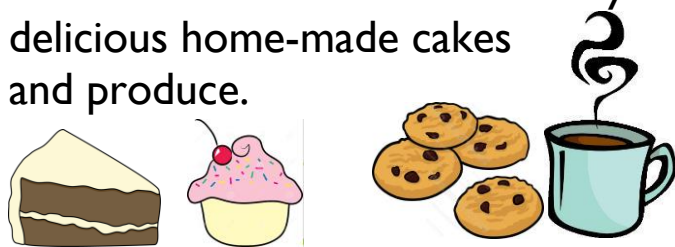
