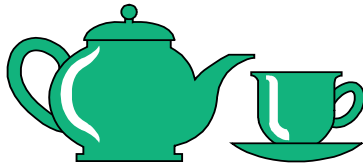

Sunday 12 May at 3pm

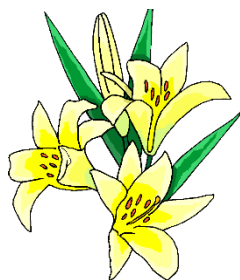

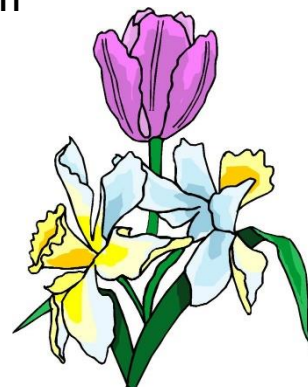
